St George Marathon Traffic Impact

On Saturday, October 5th, 2024, the City of St George will welcome 8,000 runners for the Intermountain Health St George Marathon and Half Marathon. This annual event will start in Central, Utah and end at Vernon Worthen Park in St George.

This letter provides **specific information for your neighborhood** to help residents adjust plans to accommodate the race and to minimize impacts to your day's activities. Detour signage will be placed to help you navigate around the closures.

The following traffic control will permit northbound access onto SR-18 from the Ledges to Diamond Valley. Northbound traffic will be redirected to the southbound access of SR-18. Traffic will cross SR-18 to the roundabout and be led by Pilot Car via Ledges Parkway, Winchester Rd and Hawkeye Rd to W 5745 N then via SR-18 North to Diamond Valley.

Southbound traffic will be controlled by the St George Police Department. Cars exit Ledges Parkway onto SR-18. Only one lane will be available to southbound traffic. One lane of the southbound lanes will be dedicated to northbound traffic as far as Ledges Parkway. Both Northbound lanes on SR -18 will be closed for the runners.

THERE WILL BE NO ACCESS TO THE NORTH ENTRANCE OF SNOW CANYON STATE PARK UNTIL 1:00 P.M.
